he United States Supreme Court will decide an abortion case from Louisiana in 2020—the first abortion case they have agreed to decide in three years, and the first abortion ruling of Justices Kavanaugh and Gorsuch. By June 30, 2020, the Supreme Court will make this decision regarding the abortion laws of the United States. We are praying that it will be the beginning of a new era.

The pro-death, pro-abortion side is seeking total victory in the Louisiana case, claiming that hospital admitting privileges requirements for abortionists are unconstitutional. They then plan to use this victory to strike down all abortion facility regulation laws in all fifty states. They have already filed lawsuits about this against five states—Texas, Louisiana, Indiana, Arizona, and Missouri.

We believe God has other plans and He is dedicated to and will accomplish the ending of the "covenant with death, the agreement with the grave" (Is 28) that is legalized abortion. The Lord is raising up an Army of Justice to pray for the end of legal abortion. Over a quarter million Americans have already signed the petition at www.themoraloutcry.com calling abortion a crime against humanity and asking the Supreme Court to reverse its abortion cases. You may still sign the petition.

From now, to the time of Oral Argument in Spring 2020, and until June 30, 2020, while the Court is in private deliberation mode and making a decision, please pray that the Court will reverse Roe v. Wade and other abortion cases and the Lord will bring forth Righteousness and Justice in America like a mighty champion. The "swing" justices will be thinking about and considering this case almost every day before it is released publicly. So pray often (1 Tm 2:1-8) and pray fervently (Jas 5:16).

Pray that the March for Life on January 24, 2020 will mobilize hundreds of thousands, even millions of people, to pray for the reversal of Roe v. Wade and total victory in the Louisiana Hospital Admitting Privileges Case. Pray for the Oral Argument (Spring 2020), that the lawyers for life will be persuasive and have anointed words of wisdom. Pray that the abortion industry will no longer be able to use "third party" standing to claim to act on behalf of women. Please pray for confusion in the enemy's camp and to bind the plans of the enemy of our souls and pray that the lies of the enemy be exposed and defeated.

Pray for repentance, revival, and transformation of the Supreme Court and for the salvation of every human soul on or working at the Supreme Court. Pray for the removal of the wicked as gently as possible in the Lord's perfect timing and mercy in order to end injustice.

Snowflake Adoption Celebrates the Tiniest Lives

fter many years of infertility, my husband and I made the hard decision to stop pursuing our dream of a biological child and change direction. We knew about traditional domestic adoption, international adoption, and donor eggs/sperm. Our ages did not match for international adoptions, so that was out. After much prayer, we both agreed that donor eggs/sperm was not consistent with our faith. So we began the long process of doing a home study to pursue traditional adoption, although I was not convinced that this was what was right for us. At this time, I listened to Christian radio during my long commute. Focus on the Family was a favorite show of mine because I love Dr. Dobson, During the time we were doing our home study, I heard a radio broadcast about the first "Snowflake" baby. It was the story of a woman who had infertility issues, used frozen embryos, became pregnant, and had a daughter using an "adopted embryo." I could not believe what I was hearing and immediately decided to find out more. In the mail that same day, the cover story of the Focus and the Family magazine was embryo adoption, which

they called "Snowflake" adoption. After much prayer and deliberation, we knew this was the path for our family.

Our first embryo transfer resulted in a pregnancy that ended after 8 weeks. It was devastating to me—I cried every day for several months. I knew that embryo adoption was from God; I knew this was the path God wanted me to be on even if it meant no children this side of heaven. I believed I was helping precious lives have a chance and if I was only helping them get to heaven, then I determined I would be that vessel for the Lord.

After 3 months, we tried again. This time I became pregnant with twins. At 9 weeks, one twin's heart stopped beating and again I lost a child. I was devastated, but also so thankful for the healthy baby growing inside me. This baby is my son, Jonah, a high school senior.

When Jonah was 2, we went back to the clinic to try for another child. We had adopted more remaining embryos and we were hopeful for another successful transfer. I found out that complications from the delivery of Jonah had caused scar tissue that had to be removed before an-

other pregnancy was possible. Even with the specialized surgery that was scheduled, the odds of my ever becoming pregnant again were very low. We were once again devastated but trusted God to walk us through this surgery. People all over the country were praying for me. The day of the surgery, they put me to sleep, wheeled me into the operating room, and went in to remove the scar tissue — there was none! God had healed my uterus from the scar tissue—the doctor (who was not a believer) told me it was a miracle. I was soon pregnant with my daughter Ellie,

So many different nuances happened throughout the process that kept reminding us that this was God's thing, not ours—we were just willing vessels. Never would I have thought that infertility could be a gift, but for me it was and I am forever grateful.

Donating and adopting embryos after all these years still is widely unknown. Please pray that parents of the 1 million frozen embryos waiting at infertility clinics in the U.S. would use them to complete their families or make the selfless decision to donate them to couples who are prayerfully waiting to become parents.

Shifts in the Abortion Landscape Open Opportunities for You

early a year ago, January 22, 2019, on the anniversary of Roe v. Wade, the New York State Senate passed legislation that greatly broadened abortion rights. This action was landmark. Why? Because of two things that shifted in the landscape of the ongoing battle of pro-life vs pro-abortion.

First, the abortion "fight" officially shifted to the states. Even though other states had proposed legislation for heartbeat laws and personhood laws, much of the pro-life activity in the states was pro-active—proposing and passing legislation that chipped away at abortion wherever it could find a legal means to protect life. Big abortion was still secure in their Roe v. Wade federal protections. When the New York State Senate passed their pro-abortion law it started a domino effect. Other states followed suit. Not secure to pin their abortion hopes onto the federal Roe v. Wade decision, Planned Parenthood and other pro-abortion groups began following the playbook of the prolifers and pro-actively passing state legislation that would take effect if Roe v. Wade should fall. Lesson learned? The state is the new battleground for abortion legislation and they are drawing lines. States began taking sides, passing legislation declaring themselves unborn-safe or unborn-hostile.

Second, the mask was removed on the

abortion industry. The unforgettable comments of Virginia Governor Ralph Northam pulled back the curtain on what those who support abortion really think. Let me remind you of his on-air comment: "If a mother is in labor...the infant would be delivered. The infant would be kept comfortable. The infant would be resuscitated if that's what the mother and the family desired, and then a discussion would ensue between the physicians and mother...." Examples of "comfort rooms" began popping up on social media, many explaining that the comfort rooms were sometimes a nurse's attempt to bring dignity to a process that often found delivered babies marked for "post-birth abortion" languishing unattended. We heard the truth and saw that there are no limits to the work of abortion providers in ending lives.

The abortion troops shifted their battle plan to the states, and the curtain was pulled back on the practices and mindset of the abortion industry. The battle is local, there is real hope for Roe v. Wade to be overturned, and we cannot stop praying and working to protect life.

The time to get involved in state issues is now. State and local elections are critical. It is time for us to take back our communities for our values—support pro-life candidates, seek God to ask if He is calling you to run for an office, volunteer for a campaign, organize prayer groups to support pro-life candidates—there are many ways to take action! 
"Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."
