Election 2020: Are You Standing in the Gap?

Do you hear the call? The Lord is waking up His people to see the pressing urgency of the times.

Over this last year, I have heard the Lord say to my heart, "It's a grassroots movement." Many past movements have been initiated by individuals responding to the prompting of the Lord and thus rallying the troops to respond, but this time is different. We cannot rely on one to lead the many—the many must walk as one.

I have been so encouraged in this season to hear of groups popping up all over the nation in response to the prompting of the Holy Spirit. It is so exciting to see the various meetings on beaches and in parks where the people of God are coming together to worship and pray. It continues to raise my expectation for Holy Spirit revival as I hear about these teams traveling around, igniting fires in the hearts of the people.

The Lord is looking for us to take our place. In the days of Ezekiel, the Lord looked for the faithful so that He would not have to pour out judgment on the land: "I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one." (Ez 22:30 NIV).

I believe that this time, however, God is finding what He is seeking—He is finding us, the people of God, coming together in unity to stand in the gap and intercede for our nation. My heart feels as though it is exploding as His people respond to the cry and stand in the gap in prayer

and petition for this land. Worship and intercession are incensing the altar around the clock as we humble ourselves, repent for our nation, and call on the name of the Lord.

But there is a second half to that word that we must not overlook. We must build up the wall. If we do not build up the wall for the Kingdom of God, we will find ourselves in this same devastating state sooner than we would like. We must deal with the brokenness in our land.

Our focus cannot just be on an election. It must be on turning this nation around. We need a course correction, an about-face. It starts with each one of us aligning ourselves with the purposes of God and actively pursuing His ways. We need to truly be Kingdom-of-God people, walking in righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit so that we can build up the wall and restore our nation and future generations from the conniving attacks of the enemy.

Now is not a time to stand by and observe what others are doing. The grassroots movement that the Lord is looking for requires a response from each one of us. He is calling us into action. So, stand firm, fully fitted with His armor. It is time to seek His face and walk with Him. He is calling every believer to stand in the gap and build up the wall. He is looking for you. Five Days of Action for the Election

We have prayed. We have fasted. It is down to the wire before Election Day and time for five days of action.

DAY ONE: Friday, October 30

Join us to pray together on our Prayer Webcast.

As we approach what is arguably the most contentious and the most critical election in our lifetime, we will come together as a body of intercessors to pray. You can join the webcast at www.ifapray.org/live or visit the IFA website to view, 12:15 pm ET.

DAY TWO: Saturday, October 31

Prayer walk the polling places in your area or target polling places on the map at VoteYourValues2020.com. Let's cover all of them in prayer.

Every place where you set your foot will be yours . . . (Dt 11:24)

Proclaim the blood of Jesus Christ over the area you are walking. (Eph 2:13)

Speak peace wherever you go. (Is 57:19)

Pray that believers would exercise their civic duty and vote biblical values. (Col 3:1)

Pray for citizens to recognize and accept God's design for government. (Acts 26:17-18)

Pray that candidates will take brave stands for righteousness, even when not popular. (Is 7:9)

Pray for citizens to discern what is good and what is evil. (Gal 1:3-5)

Pray for no plan of the enemy to succeed in harming the election process. (Is 54:17)

DAY THREE: Sunday, November 1

Pray for your church community to vote for biblical values on Tuesday.

Pray that pastors would reclaim their rightful position in society as leaders in the culture, advocating biblical values, addressing these issues with their congregations, and speaking out in the community. (Is 61:1-4)

Pray for the Church to engage in civic responsibilities such as voting, speaking out on issues, participating in campaigns and election management, and praying for the election process. (1 Cor 16:13)

DAY FOUR: Monday, November 2

Remind friends and family to vote.

Remind friends and family to vote personally or through social media. Offer to take elderly and/or infirm friends to vote. It's not too late to share the biblical Voter Prayer Guide to use as guidance. Fast and pray for the election.

When the righteous are in authority the people rejoice; but when the wicked rule, the people mourn. (Prv 29:2)

DAY FIVE: Tuesday, November 3

Vote! Pray at the polls!

While you vote, pray. Pollsters and campaign volunteers stand around at the polls. You can too! Pray quietly and unobtrusively.

Gather with other intercessors to pray, virtually or in person! Share the prayer provided below for Election Day.

Pray for believers to turn out in greater numbers than ever before to vote. (Prv 4:5-6)

Release blessing for godly authorities to occupy the seats of office in the upcoming election. (Rom 13:1)

Prayer at the Polls

Lord, as I vote, I recognize that government was appointed by You for Your glory. All aspects of life, including government, should be places where Your Kingdom values rule. I desire leaders who fear You and choose to support issues reflecting Your heart, for You alone are sovereign and the solution to all of our nation's problems. I dedicate my voting to You as a holy obligation to my community and nation. Let Your presence fill our nation. I pray in the mighty and powerful name of Jesus. Amen. *IFA

FIRST FRIDAY

NOVEMBER 6, 2020

On the first Friday of every month we encourage intercessors to fast and pray for America using the prayer focuses below.

ELECTION DAY

As we approach Election Day 2020, pray for Christians to vote, and to vote biblical values. Ask the Lord what He would have you do in the final days before the election. Pray for God's will in all election results, from President of the United States to local offices. Ask God for peace to reign throughout the nation.

ANSWERING THE CALL

Pray that the urgent prayers offered during the election season would continue as intercessors press into God for the nation to turn around spiritually and morally. Pray that more and more Christians would take their places, standing in the gap before God in intercession for America. Pray that we will build up the wall of the Kingdom of God and deal with the brokenness in our land. (Ez 22:30)

GIVE THANKS

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. (1 Thes 5:16-18) Give thanks to God for the growing community of IFA intercessors, praying Christians who are committed to persevering in prayer for God's will in America. GLOBAL PRAYER FOR AMERICA

The Department of **Education took decisive action** in September, refusing to pay federal grant money to schools who stay in athletic conferences that allow this.

up their voices to sing praises to Jesus in outdoor worship events led by Sean Feucht, an evangelical musician and activist. This nationwide celebration continues to bring peace to cities, with reports of rioters coming to Christ, police receiving prayer and meals, miraculous healings, and baptisms. This is in stark contrast to the destruction and violence that have been damaging communities and bringing chaos to the cities. **Praise God for bringing light** into the darkness!
