While we are shaping our nation's history through prayer and fasting, God is illuminating areas where IFA can help intercessors become more effective. We have heard from intercessors repeatedly that there are two things that would really help their intercession: First, connection and community with fellow intercessors and, second, direction about how to interface with elected officials on issues. Praying for America's Leaders, a new initiative from Intercessors for America will address these two needs—and more!

Recently we feel God has unfolded a strategy that helps strengthen ties with other local intercessors, provides more personal involvement in issues that need prayer, and offers opportunities for effective action as we band together. Our heart is to see intercession for our nation integrated into many facets of our lives—with others in your community, in the local church, among believers across your state, and as a national body of intercessors.

Praying for America's Leaders is the new initiative that builds on the interactive map-based technology from Vote Your Values and applies it to praying for your state and with others from your state. As we provide information about immediate prayer and action needs in your state, you will be able to immediately send a message, take action, pray in unity with provided prayer points, and connect with others who are also praying through Zoom prayer meetings and online forums.

This initiative is rolling out in stages. Be watching for information and invitations to pray with your state. Check out the Praying for America's Leaders website which will feature



the leaders map, your personal prayer dashboard, the Headline Prayer newsfeed, prayer resources, webcasts, videos, and more. From national to regional and state issues, involving individual intercessors standing alone and empowering churches for intercession, Praying for America's Leaders is the initiative we are praying is used by God in our nation at this strategic time.

The mandate of Intercessors for America has always been to intercede for our nation, including interceding for the various elected officials who lead it. Birthed in the era of Nixon, intercessors prayed in 1973 about Roe v. Wade, Watergate, and their concern about where America was headed. We have not run out of things to pray about! Lessons Learned from 2020

BE PREPARED

At the beginning of 2020, God began to speak one thing to me. Prepare.

Of course, I could not have imagined what was coming. Sadly, I didn't fervently pray into what He was saying. I thought He was only urging me to prepare spiritually for something ahead – which I did. But, He was telling me to prepare in the natural as well.

Since that time, I have stayed prepared. Spiritually and physically. I keep myself built up in faith. I do my best to not allow anything to shake me. To do this, I avoid the news media and instead keep my ear turned to God. I also keep my shelves filled with enough supplies to last a few weeks if need be. THE IMPORTANCE OF FAITH IN GOD AND HIS WORD

Challenges are time to allow our roots to grow deeper into God: Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. (Col 2:7)

PRO-LIFE EFFORTS

Pray for all the leaders who are working to stop the advances of pro-abortion laws and legislation. Pray for workers in pro-life pregnancy centers, for sidewalk counselors, for national pro-life organizations. May the message of the intrinsic value of the unborn take root in hearts and minds in our nation so that fewer and fewer women will choose abortion, regardless of what the laws are.

CHRISTIANS IN CONGRESS

Pray for the many Christians who are serving in Congress as elected officials or staff. Pray that they would seek God, His plans, and His purposes for our nation. Pray for humility and the recognition that God placed them in position to honor Him in government, for His glory and for the benefit of the American people.

2021: A Year of Mercy

I saw something on social media at the beginning of 2021 asking me to post my "word of the year." I laughed and scrolled on. I didn't have a word—for the year or even for the day. But in God's great mercy He gave me that very word.

I purchased a new study Bible recently and am starting at the beginning in Genesis. The first example I see of mercy in the Bible is in the Garden of Eden. I've read Genesis many times and wasn't expecting a lightning bolt to hit when I read it again. I got to Genesis 3, when the eyes of Adam and Eve were opened after they sinned. I was practically skimming it, then I read this: And the Lord God made for Adam and for his wife garments of skins and clothed them. (Gen 3:21)

I started to cry. After their direct disobedience, God had so much mercy on Adam and Eve that He clothed them Himself. I pictured a loving Father sewing clothes for His wayward children. How many times have I had the opportunity to extend mercy to someone but replaced it with judgment or anger?

Now, more than any time in recent memory, Christians are crying out to God for mercy for ourselves and our nation. We have this promise in the Bible to hold onto: We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. (2 Cor 4:8-9)

We are not crushed—when we are weak, He is strong. We are not in despair—in His presence is fullness of joy. We are not abandoned—we are heirs according to the promise. We are not destroyed—we are seated in heavenly places and have the Holy Spirit living in us.

No one exemplifies this gift of mercy more than Jesus.

And as he was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a great crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the roadside. And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" (Mk 10:46-47)

What did Jesus do? Jesus asked Bartimaeus what he wanted. The beggar wanted to see, and once Jesus restored his sight, he followed Jesus. Jesus wants to hear what we want. He cares about the smallest details of our lives. He wants us to follow Him.

In God's great mercy, He sent Jesus to die on the cross on our behalf. Such a great sacrifice can hardly be comprehended. God's mercy isn't limited by our understanding of events and circumstances. Ask Him to help you see Him, yourself, and others through His eyes, the eyes of mercy and grace.
