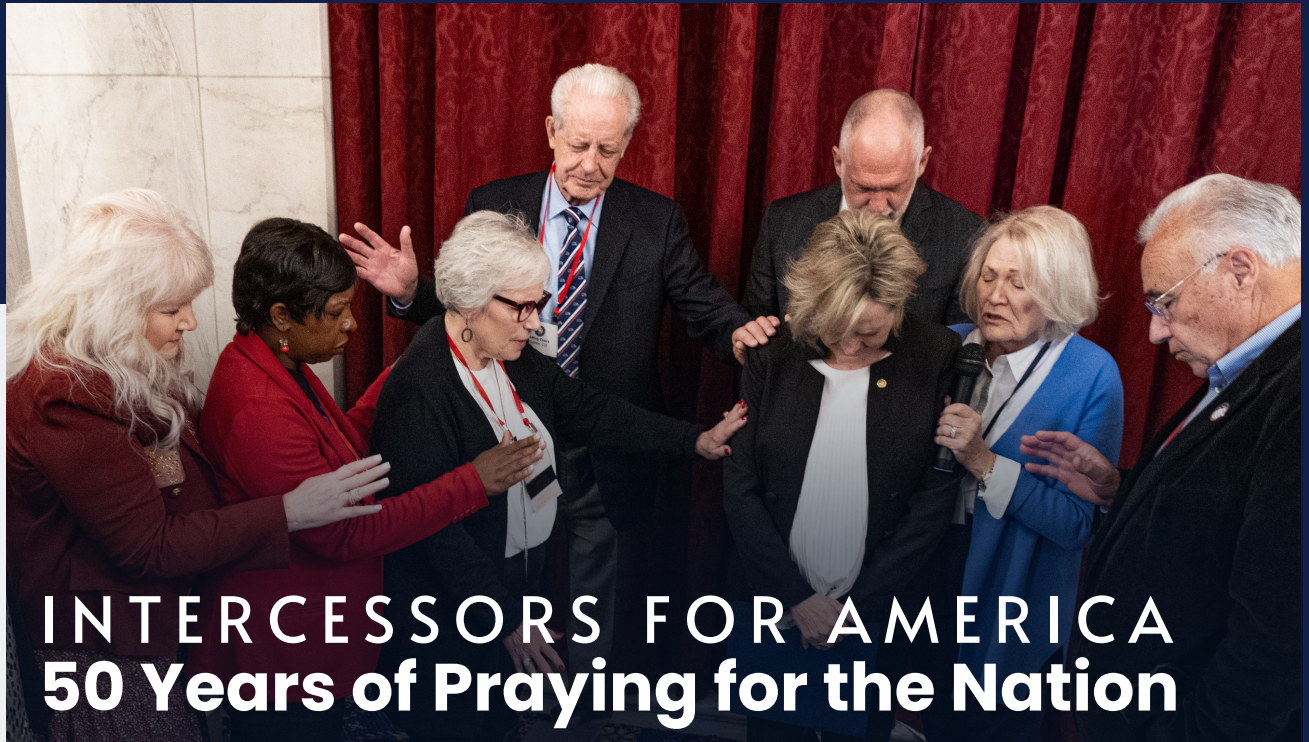
Pray that they be God-fearing and recognize that they are accountable to Him for each decision and action (Prov. 9:10).

— Benjamin Franklin, 1787
