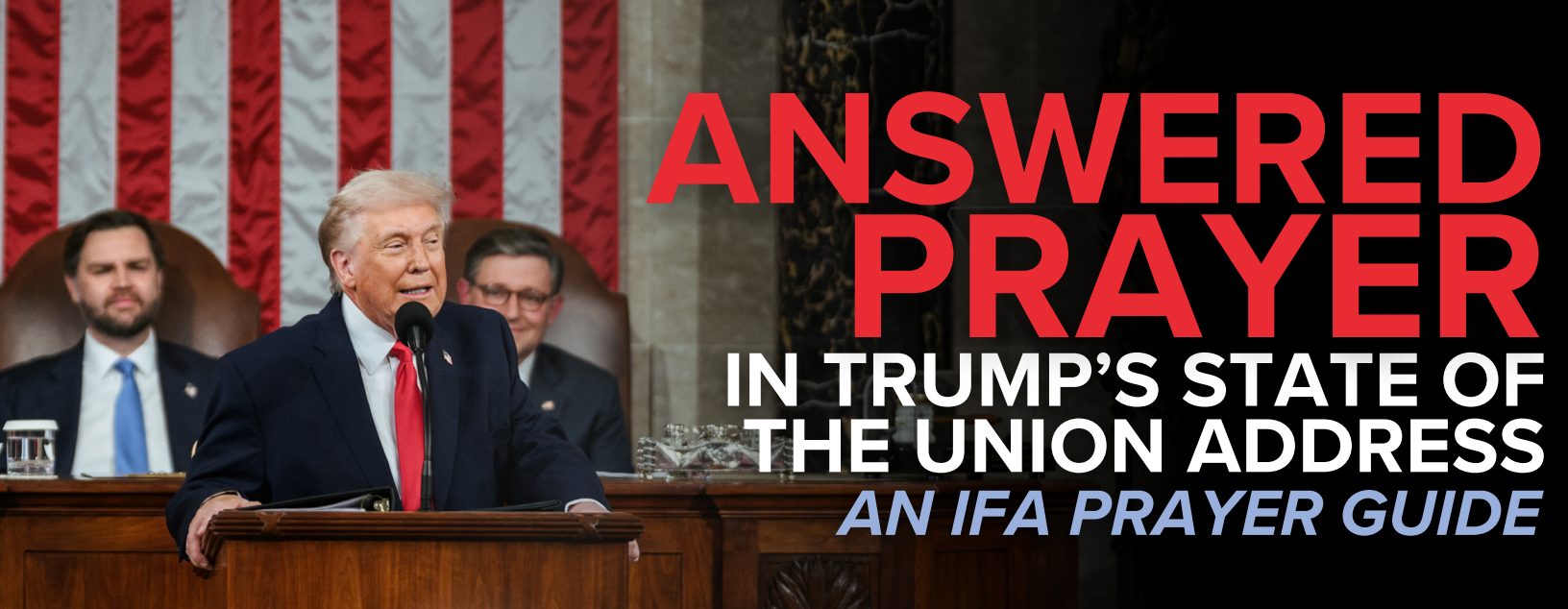




ANSWERED PRAYER

Illegal Immigration and Border Security

"Today, our border is secure."

- In the past nine months, zero illegal aliens have been admitted to the United States.
- The flow of deadly fentanyl across our border is down 56 percent in one year.

Praise God for establishing borders to protect the citizens of our great nations.

Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations (Psalm 145:13).

Inflation

- Coming from the worst inflation in history, core inflation is down, and in the last three months of 2025, it was down to 1.7%.
- Gasoline is down from its peak at \$6 a gallon under the previous administration to now below \$2.30 a gallon in most states and in some places \$1.99 a gallon. In Iowa, \$1.85 a gallon.
- The cost of groceries, hotels, automobiles, and rent is lower today than at the beginning of President Trump's term.
- Energy costs are coming down.
- Data Centers will be required to build their own power plants as part of their factory to prevent costs from going up, and in many cases, prices of electricity will go down for the community.

Economy

- The stock market has set 53 all-time record highs since the election.
- 401(k)s and retirement accounts for the millions and millions of Americans are all gaining.
- \$18 trillion of new investment into the United States versus less than \$1 trillion under the previous administration.
- Thousands of new businesses are forming, and factories, plants, and laboratories are being built.
- 70,000 new construction jobs have been added in a very short period of time.
- American Oil production is up by more than 600,000 barrels a day.
- 80 million barrels of oil have been received from our new friend and partner, Venezuela.
- American natural gas production is at an all-time high.
- More Americans are working today than at any time in the history of our country.
- 100 percent of all jobs created under this administration have been in the private sector.
- DEI has been ended cutting a record number of job regulations.
- 2.4 million Americans have been taken off of food stamps.
- The largest tax cuts in American history were delivered under the One Big Beautiful Bill
- Interest on auto loans is now tax-deductible if the car was made in America.
- No tax on tips and overtime has been instituted.
- The child tax credit has been expanded, and families can take home more than \$5,000 extra just for the year.
- Brand new "Trump accounts," tax-free investment accounts for every American child, have been created. Millions will be prefunded courtesy of the US Treasury and private individuals like Michael and Susan Dell, who have donated \$6.25 billion to fund Trump accounts for 25 million American children. The accounts could grow to over \$100,000 or more by the time they turn 18.
- The Dow Jones broke 50,000 four years ahead of schedule
- The S&P hit 7,000, where it wasn't supposed to go for many years due to tariffs.
- Tariffs ended other countries ripping off America.
- The Supreme Court ruled against President Trump in his case on tariffs; however, they will remain in place under fully approved and tested alternative legal statutes.
- The tariffs will allow for trillions of dollars to pour into America, as well as factories, jobs, and investments.
- Next year, the Trump administration will give American workers a retirement contribution match of up \$1,000 each year.
- The Trump administration wants to ensure that members of Congress cannot corruptly profit from using insider information.

Crime and Safety

- Washington, DC, is now one of the safest cities in the country.
- Last year, the murder rate saw its single largest decline in recorded history—the lowest in recorded history.
- Los Angeles is going to be safe, just like Washington, DC.
- National Guard and federal law enforcement were deployed to restore law and order to our most dangerous cities, including Memphis, Tennessee, New Orleans, and Washington, DC.

Thank You, Father, for leaders who seek to restore law, order, and justice to this nation.

Healthcare

Honoring and Celebrating Our Nation's Heroes

The following heroes and citizens were honored during the State of the Union address.

- Buddy Taggart, at age 17, volunteered to defend America in World War II, serving in the Pacific under the great General Douglas MacArthur, fighting bravely in the famous Battle of Manila. He was badly wounded and almost killed by enemy machine guns in Luzon. 81 years ago this month, he liberated the largest internment camp in the Philippines. He has earned many honors, including a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star. He will celebrate his 100th birthday on July 4, 2026.
- As flood waters rose 26 feet in a matter of minutes in Texas, Millie Kate McClelland closed her eyes and prayed to God. She thought she was going to die. Her prayers were answered by Coast Guard rescue swimmer Scott Ruskin, on his first-ever rescue mission, who descended from a helicopter above. He lifted out Millie Kate and 164 others to safety. Petty Officer Ruskin was awarded the Legion of Merit for extraordinary heroism.

- Delilah Coleman, a five-year-old in June 2024, was injured when an 18-wheel tractor-trailer plowed into her stopped car, traveling at 60 miles per hour or more. The driver was an illegal alien let in by the open borders of the previous administration. Delilah was not given a good prognosis, but is now in first grade, learning to walk.
- An Angel Moms and Families ceremony was hosted at the White House on 2/23/2026.
- The memory of Lizbeth Medina, a 16-year-old high school cheerleader who was brutally murdered in her home by an illegal alien, was honored. Her mother, Jacqueline, was honored.
- Sage Blair and her mother, Michelle, were honored. Sage was 14 when school officials in Virginia sought to socially transition her, treating her as a boy and hiding it from her parents. Sage ran away to Maryland, and a judge ruled that she would not be returned to her parents because her parents refused to call her a boy. She was thrown into an all-boys state home and suffered terribly for a long time. She was awarded a full-ride scholarship to Liberty University.
- First Lady, Melania Trump, was honored for her work with the presidential AI challenge, keeping America's next generation positioned to succeed in the future. She championed AI legislation, advancing a landmark executive order on foster care and helping secure \$30 million to launch the Melania Trump Foster Youth to Independence Initiative. She was joined by Cierra Burns and Everest Nevermont, who reflect the First Lady's impact.
- Anya Zarutsky, Iryna's mother, was honored last night. Iryna was brutally murdered on a train in North Carolina by an over 12-time convicted felon who was walking free.
- The life of Sarah Beckstrom was honored after she was killed while on duty for the National Guard in DC. Her parents, Gary and Evalea, were honored by the President and those in attendance.
- Staff Sergeant Andrew Wolfe was honored after he was shot in the head by the same gunman who killed Sarah. The doctors gave him a very poor prognosis, but his mother, Melody, told President Trump that everybody was praying and that her son would be OK. Andrew was thanked by President Trump. Both Sarah Beckstrom's parents and Staff Sergeant Andrew Wolf were awarded the Purple Heart.
- Chief Warrant Officer Five, Eric Slover, joined by his wife, Amy, was honored for his heroism during the capture of Nicholas Maduro. Slover took many hits to his hips and legs, yet he still managed to safely land the helicopter. The success of the mission depended on him. He was presented with the highest military award, the Congressional Medal of Honor.
- Royce Williams was honored for his service during World War II, Korea, and Vietnam, flying more than 220 missions. He is 100 years old and finally received the recognition he deserved after over 50 years of his story being a secret. He was presented with the Congressional Medal of Honor by the First Lady of the United States.

- President Trump designated drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations and declared fentanyl as a weapon of mass destruction.
